East Aurora High School teachers Joe Kulick and Sarah Birdsall have decided to provide a \$1,000 scholarship to one (1) East Aurora High School senior who is enrolled in both French and Band classes. This scholarship will be awarded in lieu of a favor at their wedding this upcoming summer. The student selected will have the funds directly deposited at the school of their choice pending their graduation. Requirements for the scholarship are as follows:

1. Student must be currently enrolled in any level French and Band classes with an average of a C or higher.
2. Student must hold a 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA (weighted).
3. Student must successfully graduate in the EAHS Class of 2019 (January or May).
4. Student must be enrolled in a 2- or 4-year college, university, vocation or trade school for the Fall 2019 semester.

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Application Procedures: **DUE TUESDAY, APRIL 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2019**

1. Student must complete application (attached) and submit either a digital or hard copy to Ms. Birdsall or Mr. Kulick.
2. Student must provide one (1) letter of recommendation from any East Aurora School District employee in a sealed envelope.
